VALIDATION OF NON-FORMAL AND INFORMAL KNOWLEDGE OF ADULTS

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
THREE MAIN PURPOSES OF VALIDATION IN SLOVENIA



- L. For further inclusion in formal education and labour market:
 - recognition of foreign education(ENIC/NARIC),
 - > mutual recognition of qualifications (regulated professions).
- 2. National vocational qualification system
 - National vocational qualification act (2000)



3. To record and validate knowledge, skills and competencies for easier re-employment, for job change, for career development and change, for personal development, for consideration "where I am" i "where next".




The key goals (outcomes) of validation from the perspective of individuals are::

- enabling greater flexibility and mobility in the labour market,,
- increase employability,
- development and change of professional career,
- development of competences for lifelong learning,
- validation of knowledge and experience for one's own interest, for making different individual decisions in professional and personal life,
- for guidance and advice on various further education options.

NATIONAL VOCATIONAL QUALIFICATION SYSTEM



- The need for teh system appeared in the 1990s as a result of changes in the labour market with the independence of Slovenia (SIAE participated in the development)
- ➤ The system formally came to life in 2000 with the adoption of the National Vocational Qualification Act: a system that enables the formal recognition of non formally and informally aquired knowledge, skills and comptences
- ➤ Under the Ministry of Labour, Family, Social Affairs nd Equal Opportunities
- ➤ SIAE takes care of the training of assessors: basic training lasts 4 days (32 ped. hours) or as self-directed learning (Moodle online classroom) ends with an exam; and training programmes for further professional development of assessors(5 programmes of 8 ped. hours each)
- ➤ About 700 assessors have been trained so far



GUIDANCE IN ADULT EDUCATION

Expert guidelines recommend 4 stages of the process: according to CEDEFOP

IDENTIFICATION

DOCUMENTATION

ASSESSMENT

CERTIFICATION

INFORMATION AND GUIDANCE support all 4 phases



- We have developed a procedure for informal recognition of informally aquired knowledge, skills and competences
- Counselors assess the key compteneces of adults (digital competence, learning to learn competence)

In 2024 there were 10,6% of guidance sessions in the area of validation

The purpose of counselling sessions:

- Involvement in non-formal education (44%)
- Documenting and validating non-formally and informally aquired knowledge (33%)
- Obtaining a national professional qualification (10%)
- Continuing formal education (9%)
- Employment (3%)
- Counselors do not certify
- They are professionally trained to inform and advise on formal certification procedures in Slovenia

PROFESSIONAL SUPPORT AND QUALITY







PROJECT "STRENGTHENING LIFELONG LEARNING" (2023 - 2029)

- Package 3 (one of 4 areas) strengthening of guidance activities in adult education in the field on validation:
- > Research on informal learning
- ➤ Development of an approach to identification and documentation of knowledge and skills aquired through informal learning
- > we are currently preparing a manual on the importance of validating informally acquired knowledge of adults (experts form SIAE and other experts)
- > we are developing a platform with tools and professional materials for identifying and documenting informal learning of adults
- ➤ We will prepare further training programmes for counselors
